**General Information**

The purpose of the KingCo 3A Volleyball Tournament is to determine a *league tournament champion* and seed our teams into the District 2 championships. Four (4) teams will advance to the district championships on November 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> where they will begin bracket play according to the result of league tournaments in Metro and KingCo.

**Tournament Policies and Regulation**

The tournament shall be governed by the WIAA rules and regulations, KingCo, SeaKing District 2 policy, and NHFS Rules. Pat McCarthy (Sammamish High School) will act as Tournament Director, which will be empowered to make decisions deemed necessary that are not specifically addressed in these instructions. Any item for consideration by the Tournament Committee must be submitted to the Tournament Director or the local Site manager.

**Tournament Committee (Protests – See KingCo handbook):**

If a protest occurs and a ruling is required, then the Tournament Chair will assemble a Tournament Committee, which will consist of the following:

1. Head Official or Designee

3. Three (3) head coaches not involved in the protest. This will be determined once a protest is filed.

**Admissions**

All spectators except children under 6 are required to pay an admissions fee. Please communicate the information to your fans prior to the tournament so they will come to the tournament prepared to pay the admissions.

**Passes**

KingCo Scouting, WIAA, District 2, Metro, and KingCo Lifetime passes are the only passes that will be honored. Specifically, League Faculty and District passes will not be honored. The head volleyball coach and/or Athletic Director of non-participating schools will be admitted free if their names are submitted to the Tournament Director.

**Roster and Pass List**

Each participating team must turn in a team roster and pass list to Pat McCarthy by **Monday, October 24th**. This information will be used for the program and for admission to the tournament. Roster and pass list changes may be made prior to the first match. After the first match, changes will be permitted only for illness or injury.

**Schools must submit a pass list or key personnel will be required to pay for their admission.**

**Team Arrangements**

Two courts will be available for warm-ups prior the matches. Court 1 (Main Gym) will be reserved for the first listed match opponents and Court 2 (West Gym) will be reserved for the second listed match opponents. The courts may either be shared or time may be split at 5-minute intervals depending on the desires of the coaches. There is ample room in the Main Gym for general warm-up and stretching purposes. The locker rooms will be made available. Towels will not be furnished. Valuables are the team's responsibility. Do not leave valuables in the locker room. Team members, coaches, the manager, and a statistician are the only personnel that will be permitted on the team bench during match play.

**Spectator Arrangements**

Each gym will have its own spectator arrangements, and team supervisors are responsible to see that their spectators behave in an orderly and sportsman-like manner in compliance with gym rules. The following general rules will be strictly enforced at all sites.

1. No signs other than the official school banners are allowed.
2. Artificial and or mechanical noise makers **are not** permitted.
3. Confetti **will not** be allowed. Schools violating this policy will be assessed a clean-up fee.
4. **No** flash photography will be allowed during play at any time on either court.

**Bands**

Bands are permitted at KingCo Conference tournament games. School Athletic Directors must notify the Site Manager if a school band will attend the tournament game. All band members must be accompanied by their school supervisor and appear on the pass list turned into the Site Manager.

**Match Format**

All games will be rally scoring to 25 points (no cap) with the 5<sup>th</sup> and deciding game being 15 points (no cap.). All matches will be best 3 out of 5 games. This is the same scoring format that will be used at the State Tournament. Each School will provide their own practice/warm-up balls.

**Linespersons/Scorekeepers/Libero Tracker**

Linespersons will be provided by the Greater Seattle Volleyball Officials

Scorekeepers will be provided by the host school (Sammamish)

Libero Tracker – each school must provide one (1) for their own team

**Warm-Up Balls**

Each School will provide their own practice/warm-up balls. Higher seeded team (bottom team on bracket) will provide the game ball and be the home team for that match.

**Medical and Athletic Training**

There will be a Certified Athletic Trainer present for site medical services. Taping can be done by the ATC, but each school will need to provide its own supplies. Ice and water will be available in the gym to all participants.
